6th vintage classified **Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel**

Estate classified **HVE** in July 2018. sustainable agriculture.

The vineyard

22 hectares of AOP Haut-Médoc.

Soil type: mainly **clay-limestone**.

Age of the vines: the oldest plot dates from 1959, the youngest from 2016.

Blend and harvest

67% merlot 23% cabernet sauvignon.

Tasting notes

The seventh vintage classified as Cru Bourgeois Exceptionnel, Château du Taillan 2025 stands out with a profile that is both classic and contemporary. It is notable for its aromatic intensity and freshness, placing it firmly in line with modern tastes. At the same time, it retains a more traditional dimension, supported by full ripeness, silky tannins, and a fine length. A round, deep, and powerful wine offering a broad aromatic palette.

2025 in a few points

- A dry and mild winter and spring ensured excellent vine health, followed by a hot, dry summer with occasional rainy episodes, and finally ideal conditions for the harvest.
- Precision work in the cellar: plot-by-plot vatting, gentle extraction at low temperature, precise blending, and careful handling of press wines.
